Notes from our President

Greetings.

When I was a college student in Southern California and very active in the college Jewish organization Hillel, we undergrads were asked to approach anyone showing up alone at an event and help them feel welcome. A decade later, having moved back to that same city and too old for Hillel, I visited the local temple for Friday night services. I was very disappointed that nobody greeted me, talked to me, or even turned to me to say "Shabbat Shalom" as the rabbi invited us to do at the end of the service. I did not visit that congregation again.

Fast forward to Merced years later and my first interactions at an Etz Chaim Passover seder. The members of this congregation greeted me, asked me questions, and made me feel welcome... even though I couldn't remember a single person's name or who was related to whom! The next event I showed up at was a farewell potluck for a much-loved, guitar-playing student rabbi. The members were kind to me, and everyone seemed so sad to see him go. That's when I felt like I had been missing out on something special, so I became more active.
