When you send the Recipe, please include a little blurb about it, so we get a little history as well as the recipe.

As I haven't received any recipes yet, I will provide my version of Rich's Passover Brisket Recipe, as I made it to rave reviews for my family's Seder

Brisket

Preheat oven to 200 degrees

Place the rack in the lower third of the oven.

Remove almost all of the Fat - as much as you can - from the brisket.

Sprinkle **Salt** and **Pepper** over both sides of the meat and then place it in a pan with the fattiest side up.

Shake a jar of **Heinz Chili Sauce** over the meat (you can use 2 jars if it's a large brisket)

Add a little water to the jar and shake it to release all the sauce and then sprinkle it over the meat.

Cover the meat with chopped onion, celery and carrots.

Tightly cover the pan with tin foil.

Bake for 7-10 hours, don't look at it for at least 6 hours.

A **key trick** is after it's done:

Part of the tenderness comes from slicing it against the grain.

Let it sit until it's easily handled

Scrape off all the fat and vegetables into the pan, and then flip the brisket over so you can easily see the grain

The grain on a brisket can change on one piece of meat, so pay attention, and don't fret if some parts of it get sliced into really small pieces and some into long pieces.

The vegetables and juice are delicious, but if you are cooking the brisket now to serve later then be sure to **scoop some of the juice onto the sliced meat** to keep it from drying out – but not so much that it's swimming in it.

If you're serving it right away, then serve the sliced meat with the vegetables.

Note: You can pour kosher for Passover wine into the Chili Sauce jar to loosen the sauce, instead of water – if it's not Passover beer works well too.

Join Us for Etz Chaim's Weekend in the Woods June 6-8

An opportunity to contemplate G-d in G-d's country.

On the weekend of June 6, 7 & 8th Rich Kleitman is inviting members of our congregation to join him for a break from the Valley. This is an annual trip, sometimes called a "Shabbaton," is a chance to head up to his cabin in Sierra Village (up above Twain Harte on Highway 108). It's a chance to break bread together (really it is usually Spaghetti for dinner, waffles or pancakes for breakfast and sandwiches for lunch). Bring your own beverages of choice. The visit is very much a do your own thing event. Arrive any time after 4 pm on Friday through 3 pm Sunday. Come for the day or come for the weekend. If you are staying, just pick a sleeping space and then we can play the activities by ear. Card games, campfire stories and Smores, nature hikes, playing pool or sitting on the deck and enjoying the view and getting to know each other better. If anyone is so inclined, they could lead a brief Torah study or adult education session. Day trips in the area could include hiking at nearby lakes, a visit to the casino/bowling alley, a visit to Columbia State historic park, or just excursions to local restaurants and shops.

The cabin has a master bedroom with a king-sized bed and two single futons and a downstairs bedroom with two extra-long twin beds, a large master closet that is large enough for a cot or sleeping pad, and a hallway where we can put a queen-sized air bed. Upstairs there is a bedroom with a queen-sized sofa bed in it, a living room with a queen-sized sofa bed, and plenty of space to sleep others on pads on the floor. In the separate garage there is a queen-sized sofa bed and floor space for 10 folks to sleep on pads next to the pool table, but there is not a bathroom in the garage so you will need to walk back to the house to use one of the two bathrooms. The house has a full kitchen, a woodstove, a gas and a charcoal grill, an outdoor fire bowl, a deck table and chairs, and a large dining room table that sits up to 10 folks at a time easily.
